Dear Parents,

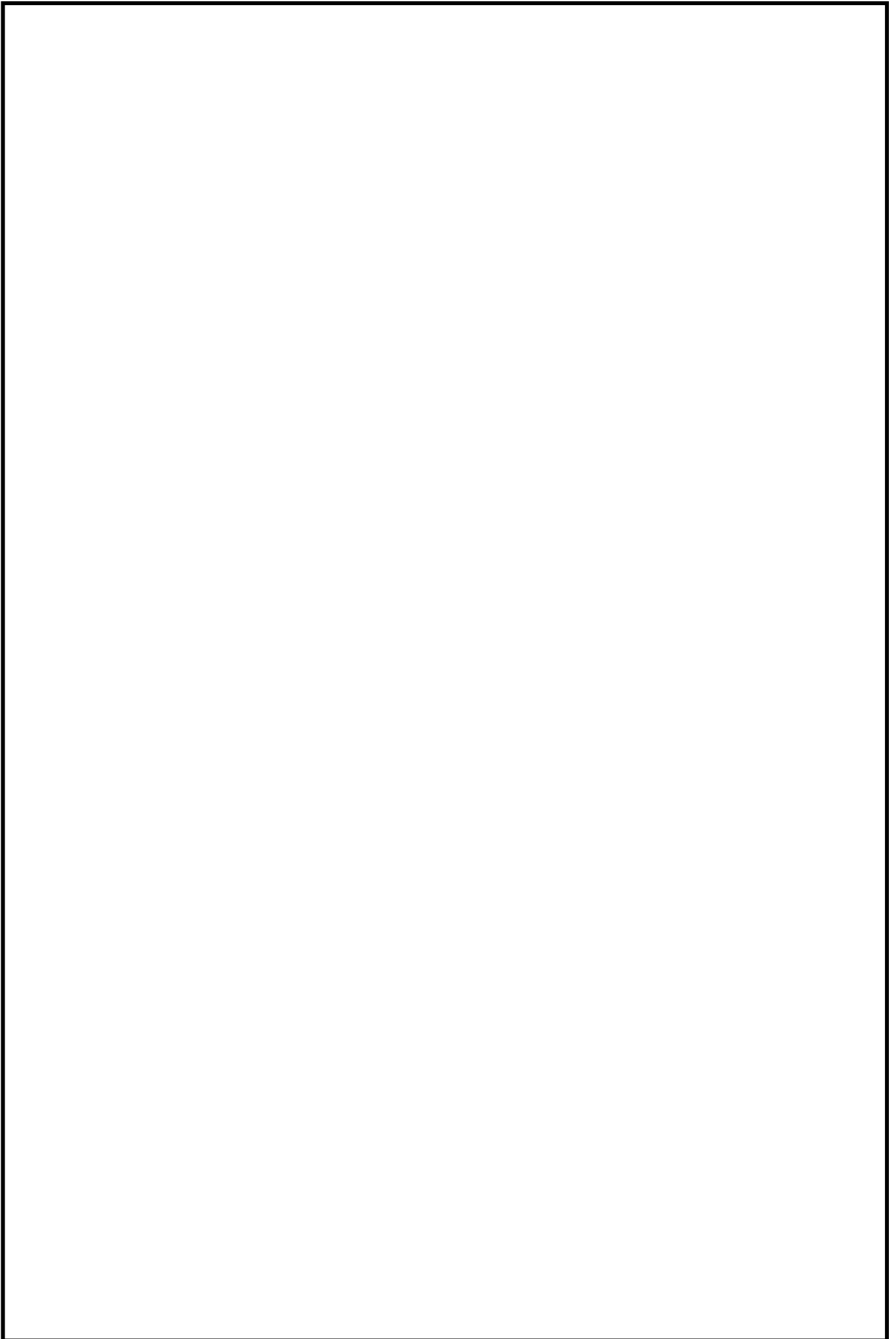

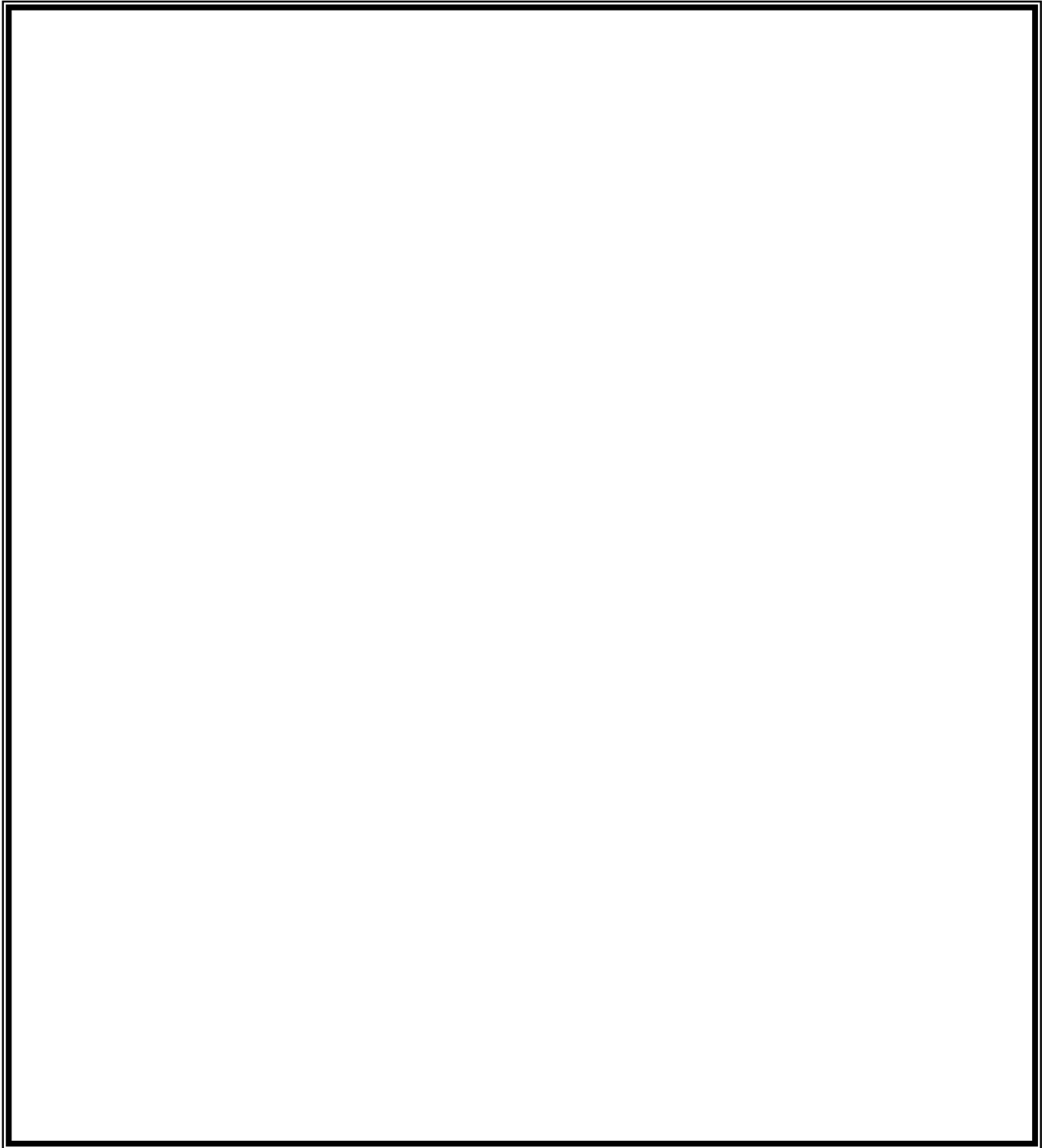
