St Kevins (180 students)

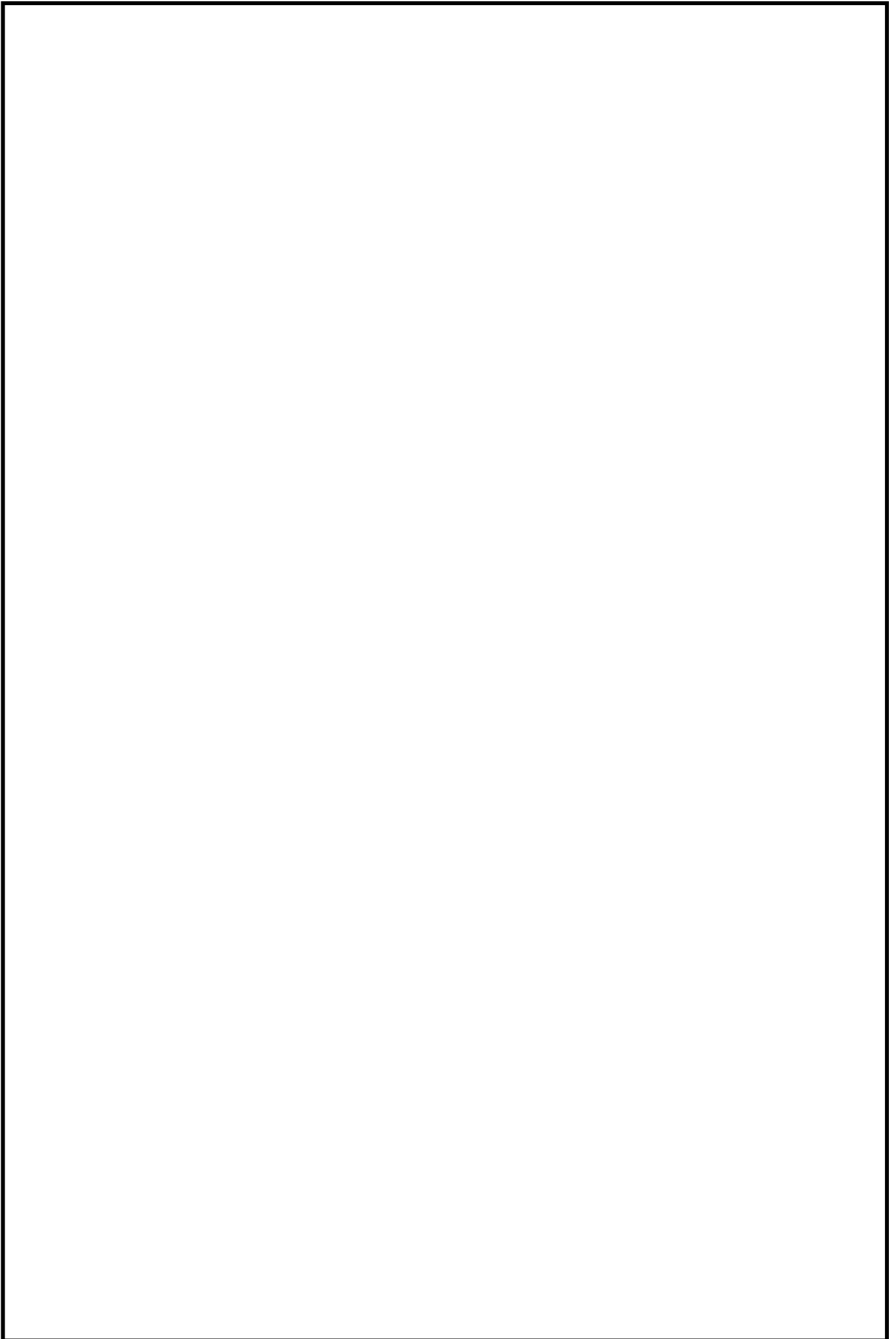

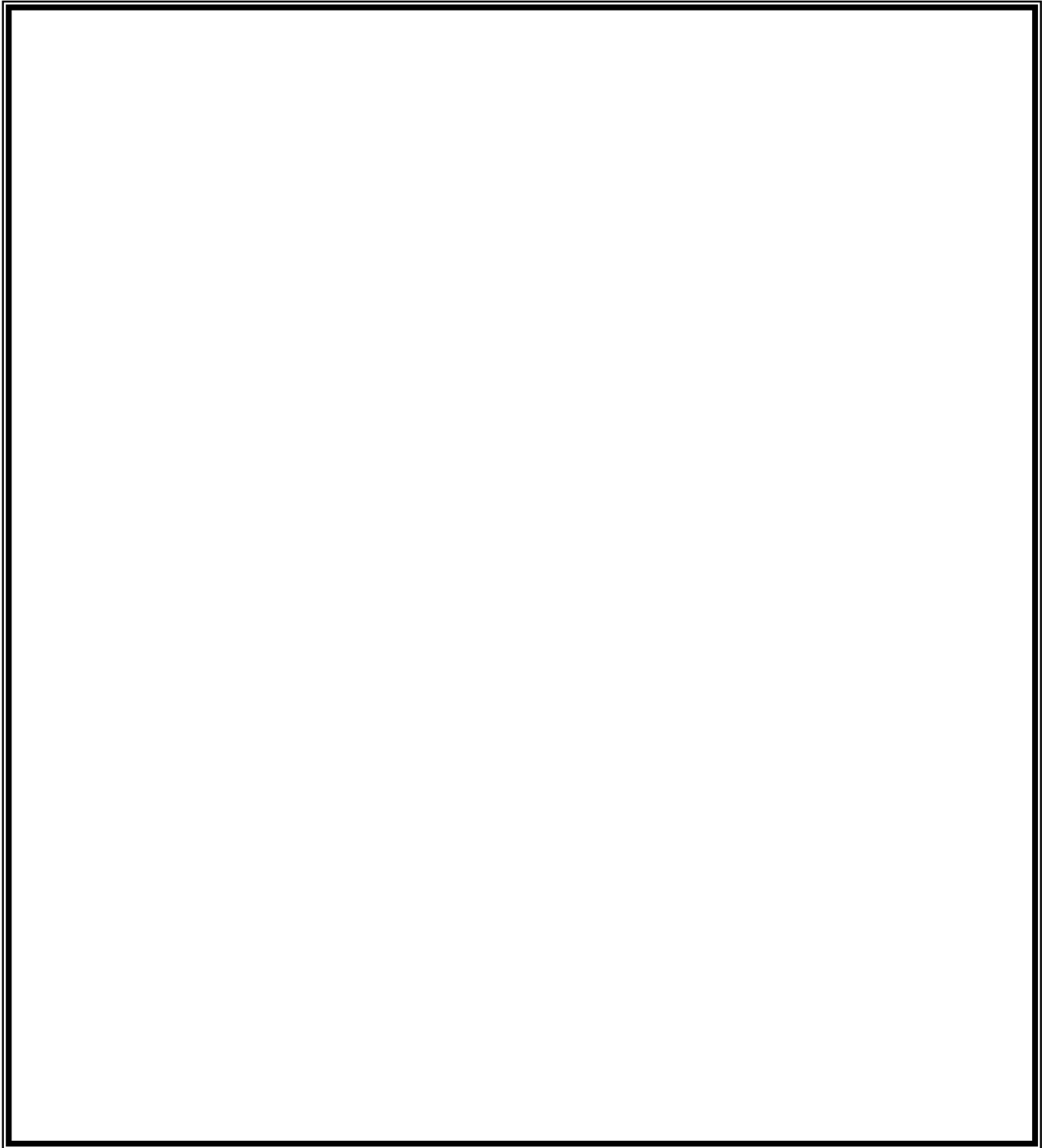
