Welcome to our new Foundations students!

It was a very exciting time in the Foundation rooms today, their first day at school! It was lovely seeing all the new students arriving dressed in their school uniforms eagerly looking forward to starting school. The Foundation students have settled in well and are working beautifully.

The Year 3-6 swimming program has been very smooth. The feedback has been positive from the pool and the students are looking forward to the House Swimming Carnival at Aquarena. This is always a fun day with the children racing against one another. There are events suitable for swimmers and non-swimmers.

Please remember:

The school day begins at 9.00 am. It is important that students are at school and settled in their classrooms by 9.00 am.

Also morning drop off should not be prior to 8.45 am. The playground is not supervised until 8.45 am and classrooms are open at that time.

Please be mindful of our students when driving to school in the mornings and afternoons. There are clear traffic guidelines sign posted. There should be no parking in the staff car parks. Common sense and care should be taken at all times. Our children are very precious!

It is important that all students come to school refreshed and ready for their learning. Primary school aged students require 9 – 11 hours sleep per night to maximise their learning potential, health and well being.

A MESSAGE FROM JAROD

Lately we have been noticing more and more students arriving late to school. Punctuality is an important life skill, and our motto is 'Learning for Living'.

Enjoy more time to prepare for class

Students arriving to school with time to spare have the luxury of settling in, preparing their class materials and focusing their minds on the lessons to come.

Students showing up to class in the middle of a lesson miss out on this natural transition period and may lose even more of the lesson as they scurry to settle into an academic focus.

Arriving late to school can also mean that students miss out on activities designed to build connections with their peers, potentially impacting their social interactions and making connections with their classmates.



1. Prepare your clothes the night before
2. Prepare your school lunch the night before
3. Prepare your school bag (readers, books, homework, drink bottle)
4. Prepare by letting as much light as you can into your rooms
5. Prepare by splashing some water on your face and playing your favourite music
6. Prepare for bed by stopping screen time 30 minutes before sleep
7. 6 to 12 years old, try to get 9-12 hours of sleep every night.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors, excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works and sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students

HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

If you applied for the CSEF at your child's school in 2019, you do not need to complete an application form in 2020 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools in 2020 or you did not apply in 2019.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2020.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.


