WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK / CHILD SAFE

The Victorian Government is committed to the safety and wellbeing of all children and young people. As part of the Victorian Government's commitment to implementing the recommendations of the Betrayal of Trust report, which found that more must be done to prevent and respond to child abuse in our community, there is a new regulatory landscape surrounding child safety, underpinned by the new PROTECT Child Safe Standards.

At Donburn, we are confident that all Child Safe standards are being met and that all children are safe and cared for. In line with the Child Safe practices, all volunteers within the school, including parents who are assisting, must have a current Working with Children Check. This procedure is to ensure all children are safe.

Last year getting a new working with children check went 100% digital meaning for people with the right identity proofing documents you don't need to go to the Post Office anymore. I'm not sure how much volunteering we'll be able to do this year, but I have included the link below for your reference.

Lately we have been noticing more and more students arriving late to school. Punctuality is an important life skill, and our motto is 'Learning for Living'.

Enjoy more time to prepare for class

Students arriving to school with time to spare have the luxury of settling in, preparing their class materials and focusing their minds on the lessons to come.

Students showing up to class in the middle of a lesson miss out on this natural transition period and may lose even more of the lesson as they scurry to settle into an academic focus.

Arriving late to school can also mean that students miss out on activities designed to build connections with their peers, potentially impacting their social interactions and making connections with their classmates.




- 1. Prepare your clothes the night before

- 7. 6 to 12 years old, try to get 9-12 hours of sleep every night.



CAMPS SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS (CSEF) FUND APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR CARD HOLDERS

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time, please contact the school office and ask for an application form.

You can also download the form, and find out more about the program and eligibility, on the Department of Education and Training's Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund web page.

Check with the school office if you are unsure, and please return completed forms to the school office as soon as possible.




