


Congratulations to all 2017 Year 6 students who cared for their buddies during this introduction - I'm sure 2017 will be very productive for all involved in our buddies program!



Lessons are for a half hour each week and your child is collected from class by their music teacher and delivered back.



A CHAMPION AT DONBURN



On the 10th, 11th, and 12th of November, I competed in Geelong in the Trans Bass Challenge and the Junior Victorian Championships for Women's Artistic Gymnastics. The Trans Bass Challenge was a competition against gymnasts from Tasmania and South Australia, whilst the Victorian Championships was a competition against girls from all around Victoria.


Earlier in the year, I competed in competitions to qualify for these final events. I had to be top 6 in the qualifiers to make the state team to represent Victoria in the Trans Bass Challenge. At a different qualifying competition, I had to be top 2 in my age group to make it as an individual for the Victorian Championships. I was lucky to qualify as an individual and my team qualified too.

I had to travel with the state team to Geelong in advance and spend 2 nights with Team Victoria. Friday 10th November was the Trans Bass Challenge, in which the Victorian teams came first on every apparatus and all around. As an individual, I placed 1st on beam and 2nd on vault, bars and all around.

On the 11th, I competed in the Junior Victorian Championships as an individual. I came 2nd on vault and beam and 1st on bars, floor and all around, making me the Victorian Champion for Level 6 Under 12s.

On the final day of competition, I competed in the team event of the Junior Victorian Championships. My team came 1st on everything, making us the 2017 Victorian Champion Team for Level 6. I am very proud of my team and my achievements!

Then we rode down back towards the basketball area. Here we practised some more u-turns and slow riding. Also, we entered a roundabout, used hand signals to turn right and left then exited onto the oval to ride around the track and we had to watch out for 'kangaroos'.

We then had to start the course again but we had to watch out for other riders and give way to avoid bike accidents.

The weather was nice and hot and we were lucky that the workman with their trucks weren't there. The course was approximately one kilometre long and some people did about 6 –7 laps. We felt tired but we enjoyed the session.

Oliver Pa won the 'Best Rider Award' for listening and demonstrating great bike skills and Marina G got a T-shirt for the most improved rider.

We would like to thank all the Year 5 parents and teachers who helped out with bike education. It was a wonderful, awesome experience!


